We have designated the Sundays in October as “Sock It To Me Sundays”. We will collect socks of all types during the month of October and these will be given out through the food pantry.

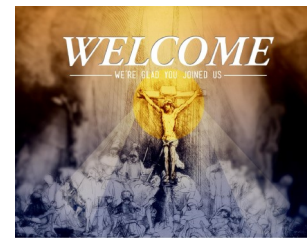
