

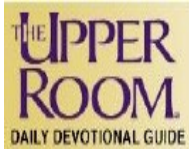

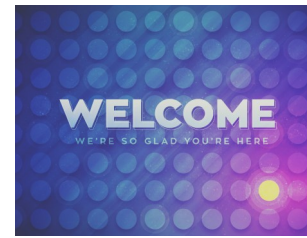
For the month of April, we need
